Dear Childcare or Preschool Provider:

This brief communication is the first of what will likely be many to come regarding pandemic H1N1 influenza (aka "swine flu") during the coming year. As you know, this virus has been causing illness, typically mild/moderate but rarely severe, throughout the summer – more so than in the spring even though it received more media attention when it first arrived. With the increased spread of infections that is likely with start of the school year, and the upcoming "regular" flu season, we are anticipating considerably more cases than seen in recent months.

On Friday, August 10th, federal officials held a press conference announcing the release of new guidance and other information regarding the prevention and control of H1N1 flu in school settings. Specific guidance for childcare and preschool settings will be available soon, but much of the information for schools will be useful in your setting until that specific guidance is available.
